

PROJECT BRIEF SOUTH AFRICA

Smallholder farmers in South Africa are heavily exposed to weather-related events like drought. Mid-2015 and early 2016, drought drastically reduced water supplies and agricultural production in the country. Maize and other crops did not grow, livestock was threatened to starve, thus farmers and their families were impacted not only by loosing their income but also risking famine. Land Bank Insurance of South Africa and CelsiusPro join forces to develop and introduce crop and livestock insurance to smallholder farmers. Up to now, only commercial farmers have access to insurance covers, since insurance is not available for smallholder farmers. The distribution channel includes bundling of the drought insurance product with loan disbursements offered by the Land Bank and co-operatives such as Suidwes and Unigro. Drought insurance offers long benefits including term poverty alleviation. employment creation. increased resilience and stabilization of farming income.




PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES SUPPORTED
